International Guitar Competition “Julian Bream” - 1st Edition 13-16 April 2023 – Trieste (Italy)

Regulations

Art. 1 – International Guitar Competition “Julian Bream” will take place in Trieste, from 13 to 16 April 2023.
Registrations deadline: **26 March 2022**.

Art. 2 – The competition is open to Italian and foreign musicians

Art. 3 - The Competition includes the following sections

Category A: soloists born before 31/12/2012

Category B: soloists born before 31/12/2009

Category C: soloists born before 31/12/2005

Category D: soloists under the age of 19

Art. 4 – Participation in one or two categories is allowed.

Art. 5 - registrations will close on **26 March 2023 at 11.59 pm**; it is possible to contact us at the following email: scuoladimusica@orchestradiati.it or visit the website www.orchestradiati.it

Art. 6 - Registration for the competition implies the unconditional acceptance of these regulations and any changes approved by the organization board

Art. 7 – The judging commission will be composed of musicians active in both the didactic and artistic fields. If one of the members of the commission has had educational contacts with the competitors, he must abstain from voting.

Art. 8 – The Commission's judgment is final and unquestionable and will be expressed by voting from 1 to 100. The results will not show scores lower than 80/100, which will be communicated personally only upon request.

The commission's judgment in cents is the result of the average score obtained, assigning the prize as follows:

from 98 to 100 cents: Absolute First Prize,

from 95 to 97 cents: First Prize (1st Prize Diploma);

from 90 to 94 cents: Second Prize (2nd Prize Diploma);

from 85 to 89 cents: Third Prize (3rd Prize Diploma).

Art. 9 – The winners chosen by the commission will perform in the concerts organized by “Civica Orchestra di Fiati G. Verdi”

Art. 10 - The program of the maximum expected duration is free for categories A, B and C. For category D there is an obligatory piece. Maximum durations:

Category A: max 5 min.

Category B: max 7 min.

Cat. C: max 10 min.

Cat. D: max 12 min, obligatory piece: "Homenaje pour le tombeau de Debussy" by Manuel De Falla (ed. J.W. Chester & Co., Rev. Miguel Llobet).

Art. 11 - PARTICIPATION FEES:

One category: Euro 50.00

Two categories: Euro 60.00

The participation fee is non-refundable.

N.B.: "COMBO" packages are provided with the participation fee included for those who participate in other activities of INTERNATIONAL GUITAR FESTIVAL 2023 – 10th EDITION (masterclasses, guitar orchestra, workshops, concerts, etc. SEE APPLICATION FORM).

Art. 12 - REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- 1) Double-sided copy of identity card or passport
- 2) Receipt of payment of the registration fee by bank transfer

- 3) One PDF copy of the repertoire performed during the competition. All competitors will be required to be in possession of the ORIGINAL score.

Art. 13 - AWARDS / Scholarships

Cat A € 100 for 1st absolute

Cat B € 150 + 1 concert for 1st absolute

Cat C € 250 + 1 concert for 1st absolute

Cat D € 500 + 1 concert for 1st absolute

The second and third place in each category will receive a medal.

All registered participants will receive a certificate of participation.

Art. 14 – AWARDS Concert

The concert of the Winners and the award ceremony will be held free of charge on Sunday 16 April 2023 at Sala Luttazzi, Magazzino 26, Trieste.
